# APOTHECARY JAR CELESTIAL MOTH



## MATERIALS

- X-LG Canister W/Seal (SKU CCX069)
    - Sponge
  - Small round brush
    - Liner brush
  - Pattern sheet
  - Tissue Paper
  - Dark water-based marker
    - Pencil
    - Paint
- 82,92,31

## TIPS

- Allow paint to dry between coats.
- Wash brush between colors.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Trace the design from the pattern sheet onto the tissue paper with a pencil.
2. Place the tissue paper pattern on the pottery and trace over the lines with a dark water-based marker.
3. Dip a damp sponge in #82. Wipe a light coat of color on the outside of the jar and lid.
4. Paint 3 coats of #92 on the moth wings and lid knob, letting each coat dry before moving on to the next coat.
5. Paint 3 coats of #31 on the eyes, moon, and triangles on the body.
6. With a liner brush, outline and detail the body, wings, and antennas of the moth with #31.
7. Paint 3 coats of #31 on the edge of the lid and the top and bottom rims of the jar. Let dry completely.
